SERVICE CHARGE VS. GRATUITY

One of the most frequently asked questions by members is, "What is the difference between service charge and gratuity?"

A service charge of 18% is added to your normal food and beverage transactions. Of that total, 13% goes to the club to offset our higher hourly payroll cost and 5% goes into a pool for the entire serving staff. Each week that pool is distributed to the servers who worked based on their hours worked. On average, it gives our servers \$1 to \$2 more per hour worked. So when you see the "service charge" line on your bill, please know the amount shown does not go directly to your server.

If you choose to add gratuity to your bill, 100% of that goes directly to your server. Gratuities are not expected, but are much appreciated!

Innual Meeting Recap Friends, At the Annual Membership Meeting on October 10, 2024, out-going President Lee Newsome delivered an address describing our club's accomplishments over the past year and his vision for our club in the coming years. Presented here is a summary of his remarks. • We currently have 376 members. • Our "big note' was \$1,700,000 in 2010 and will be under \$1,000,000 by the end of October. • Our Stewardship fund is working very well. In the past year we replaced two air conditioners, the walk-in cooler in the kitchen, and landscaped our Fairview Drive border. In past years this would have required a membership assessment. But our Stewardship Fund paid for all of these expenses. • We were able to pay off our operating line of credit by the end of the year. • We are having significant success developing our junior golfers. The fact that Braceton Beasley became our Club Champion this year is evidence of that. Our Member-Guest Tournament was a significant success this year and is becoming our signature event. All excellent golf courses have a signature clock. Jimmy Allgood and Louie Curry spearheaded a successful effort to raise money for our beautiful new clock and many members contributed. • We are facing headwinds in the year to come. The hurricane inflicted severe damage on our golf course. Property tax increases could be over \$20,000. Insurance premiums might increase over \$15,000. Inflation is impacting many of our operating expenses. · Your directors feel it is important to increase dues, beginning with November, by 4% across the board, to help us meet these headwinds. • We have a long-term vision for our club. We have a visual long-range plan for our golf course. We are thankful for the contributions of Jeff Graham that have allowed us to get started on that plan. · We also have a vision for our social offerings. We are an important asset for this community, providing a venue for banquets and social events. We want to be the premier social destination, just as we are the premier golf destination in our area. We have a committee working on this vision and look forward to presenting a specific concept to you over the next year.
