Annual Membership Meeting Recap

The Dublin Country Club (DCC) held its Annual Meeting on Thursday, September 25, 2025, bringing together members, board members, and staff to review the past year's accomplishments and discuss plans for the year ahead. Fabulous drinks and eats were prepared by the hardworking DCC team and enjoyed by all.

A highlight of the evening was being able to honor Preston Anderson and his wife Gloria. Preston celebrates a remarkable milestone this year, having worked at DCC for 40 years! We are so grateful to him for everything he has done for our Club and look forward to many more to come.

Kicking off the business portion of the meeting, Tim Veal with Nichols Cauley presented the annual financial report.

President Michael Maffett provided remarks on the Club's challenges and achievements over the past year, including hurricane damage, epic snowfall, and staffing challenges on the course. He took the opportunity to thank several individuals who stepped up to help the Club to assist while we continue the Superintendent search:

Thank you to Chad Payne, Bill Middlebrooks, Lee Newsome, Johnny Layton, Dan McManus, Ronnie Carter, Richie Hogan, Jack Tribble.

Thank you to our grounds team and John Wavrick.

Special thanks to Jeff Graham for numerous donations including new maintenance shed.

His presentation shifted from his President's Report to a Future Development Plan for DCC. Mr. Maffett began by providing a case study example of a recent Club renovation project done at Forest Heights Country Club. Their Club is similar in that they faced the same challenges DCC faces currently: Outdated Facilities – Last major DCC renovation 1999-2000; Structural issues throughout the Club due to deferred maintenance; Tennis Courts need replacement/repair – not just an eyesore they are a hazard; and lack of casual dining opportunities outside of the Pub area. The solution presented: Modernize Clubhouse facilities and address structural/deferred maintenance issues; Enhance outdoor amenities; and Boost membership value. Discussion took place amongst those in attendance and a unanimous vote was made by the membership to renew the Club's main note from \$975,000 to \$1.725 million. The amortization of 17.5 years will keep the same debt service of \$15,500 a month and allocate \$750,000 to a Club renovation project.

The meeting concluded with the recognition of outgoing board members Bob Buzzell and David Roberts and gratitude shown to Michael Maffett for his leadership as 2024-2025 DCC President. Announcements were made acknowledging Randy Duggins as a new Board Member and Chad Payne was announced at the 2025-2026 Board President.

Thank you to all who attended and supported the effort to continue to make the Dublin Country Club a great place to be a member!


